

CHATTAHOOCHEE PARK HANDICAP HUNTING RULES

1. Each hunter must complete an application available from the Wildlife Section, 64 North Union Street, Montgomery, AL 36130; or by calling (334)242-3469.
2. The application process certifies individuals are physically disabled under guidelines established by the American Medical Association, Veterans Administration, or the U.S. Social Security Administration.
3. Hunting is restricted to three days per week, Sunday, Tuesday & Thursday, so that deer are not pressured and forced to become nocturnal in their activities. Hunting dates will be from November 1, 2007 to January 31, 2008.
4. Reservations will be made on a first call basis. A hunt may be scheduled only on one area for each date. No participant may hunt on one area more than once every two weeks. The two weeks begin on the day you hunt. However, if a vacancy exists, any participant, regardless of when that individual last hunted, may schedule a hunt within 24 hours of a scheduled hunting date. This hunt will not count toward the once every two-week limit. If you make a reservation and are unable to hunt, the reservation must be canceled 48 hours before the scheduled hunt. This will allow others to utilize the area. Failure to cancel and then not hunt will be considered the same as if you did hunt in determining the next date you will be eligible to reserve for hunting. Each participant must carry this letter as a permit at each area on each hunt day. In addition, each participant must show a current state hunting license. If you require assistance to hunt, it will be your responsibility to provide the assistance. Both you and the assistant must wear the required hunter orange but only you will be allowed to hunt.
5. Hunting is by reservation only and each participant must check in and out on the date reserved. There are three hunting locations. (Plot #1, Plot #2 & Plot #3)
6. All hunting is from shooting houses located on wildlife openings only.
